What is Title I and How Can I be Involved?

Definition of Title I:

- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are low achieving or at most risk of falling behind.
- Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.
- Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a schoolwide program.



EAGLE operates a Title I Schoolwide Program.



Schoolwide means:

- The school uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school.
- Title I funds are used to serve all children in order to raise academic achievement.
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting the State's performance targets.

To be a "Schoolwide" School:

- The school must have a free/reduced lunch count of at least 40%.
- The school must collect and analyze data that effects student achievement.
- The school must develop a comprehensive site plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan.

Summary:

• At EAGLE, we analyze data from the NWEA-MAP and STEP assessment that our scholars are given throughout the year. We identify scholars who are struggling to meet the targets set forth, and then we provide them with targeted, specialized instruction in Learning Support groups, which are small groups that work to reteach and develop the scholar's areas of difficulty.



Focus Goals

• Scholars will grow 1.5 years in both ELA and math.



Curriculum and Instructional Strategies:

- At EAGLE we use a robust and rigorous curriculum to ensure that our scholar's are college and career ready.
- ELA Engage NY Core and STEP aligned reading comprehension, read aloud, and LifeLong Readers guided reading; blended learning.
- Math Engage NY; blended learning
- Writing Lucy Calkins
- Science MySci via Washington University
- Social Studies- Success Academy Education Institute



Assessments:

- Scholars are assessed every few weeks with the STEP assessment.
- Scholars are assess three times per year (Fall, Winter, Spring) with the NWEA-Map assessment.
- Scholars are assessed throughout the year with Engage NY math and ELA assessments.
- 3rd-8th grade scholars will participate in the Missouri state testing in the Spring.



Intervention and Support

- Scholars who are struggling will receive double guided reading and math instruction on their individual level.
 - Reading Teachers
 - Reading Specialists
 - Math Teachers
